We are aware of the cost-of-living pressures on families and there is no expectation at all that parents send in sweets for the class to celebrate their child's birthday or other event.

If you wish to celebrate your child's birthday with the class, we welcome a donation of a book to the class library rather than sending in sweets. If you do this, we will put a book plate inside the front cover to show that you have donated the book.

If you decide to share sweets, please check the ingredients very carefully and do not send in anything containing nuts. **We cannot give out any food where ingredients cannot be verified.** Many children cannot eat gelatine, which is often found in sweets, as it is an animal derived product and is therefore not suitable for children who are vegetarians for cultural or religious reasons.

If sweets are handed out after school, we ask for your cooperation in ensuring that these are eaten once the children have left school grounds.
