#### Dear Parents/Carers,

We have had a few queries about uniform so I thought it would be helpful to answer them all here.

#### Footwear

Children may wear black, brown, blue or red leather type shoes. These should have a T-bar, ankle strap, Velcro or laces so they do not fall off. No trainers please. Children may wear wellington boots outdoors when it is wet/there is snow. These must be taken off and school shoes put on once the child is in the classroom. Children may wear short ankle boots (that finish at the ankle), but not calf or knee length boots.

#### Socks

These should be grey or white.

#### Art

Children should wear an apron for art so that their uniform is protected. An old shirt is ideal for junior children. If the sleeves are altered to make elasticated sleeves, they are perfect!

#### Jewellery

Any earrings should be flat to the ear please. The children need to remove these themselves for PE or have them taped.

Necklaces may only be worn for religious purposes. These also need to be removed or taped for PE.

The school cannot take responsibility for any valuables that are lost or broken so please consider what you send in.
