All schools that use aptitude and academic testing as part of their admission arrangements must make arrangements for these tests and inform parents of the outcome of these tests before the secondary transfer application deadline. This is to ensure that parents are able to make an informed choice of school. The South West Herts

The academic testing for these schools for September 2025 admissions will take place in September 2024. Y5 parents may register their child with the Consortium between Monday 8th April and Friday 14th June 2024. More information will follow once the registration process opens.
