Y5 Natural Disaster Art Day

On natural disaster day, we did a number of different art projects. We were split into six groups and we mixed classes.

One of the art pieces was creating papiermâché volcanoes; we made them by soaking paper in glue and sticking it on to a plastic bottle.



We also made clay tsunamis; we used special clay tools and we shaped the clay into a wave.



We made zentangle fire patterns on a square piece of card that we were given (using the colours red, orange and yellow) which will be put together to make a big picture of amazing art.



After that, we made asteroids using oil pastels and chalk pastels and made multiple pieces of colourful art. After finishing that, we moved on to painting watercolour tsunamis and used lots of different strokes and techniques and we made beautiful pieces.



Finally, we made acrylic paint volcanoes on a black canvas using an easel and we used all the skills that we have been taught to make it, especially our splats! We had loads of fun making these pieces of art.

Safeguarding

Schools have a duty to safeguard and promote the welfare of children who are their pupils. The Children Act 1989 places a clear responsibility on schools to ensure that they work with other agencies to safeguard and promote the welfare of all children. The local authority requires head teachers to report any obvious or suspected cases of child abuse, which includes non-accidental injury, physical neglect, emotional abuse and/or sexual abuse. This procedure is intended to protect children at risk. As a result, if concerns are raised within school, we have a legal obligation to report them to Children's Services.

We have a school Child Protection Policy and a copy of the HCC Area Child Protection Procedures, which are available for parents to view. Miss Mylotte is the 'Designated Safeguarding Lead' (DSL) for child protection and is happy to discuss any questions or concerns that you may have related to child protection. Miss Norris, Mrs Morley and Mrs Wicks are the deputy DSLs. In line with our Child Protection Policy, all adults working in school undergo a

thorough vetting procedure, including an enhanced DBS check.

Killigrew is part of a scheme that runs jointly between schools and Hertfordshire Constabulary. Operation Encompass is the notification to schools, prior to the start of the next school day, of incidents where a child has experienced or been exposed to any domestic abuse. Operation Encompass ensures that the DSL is trained to allow them to liaise with the police and to use the information that has been shared in confidence. They also ensure that the school can make provision for possible difficulties experienced by children or families who have experienced a domestic abuse incident.
