This year, the theme of British Science Week was 'Time'. We started off the week with an exciting assembly show led by Lightning Lauren from Mad Science, who took us through some fascinating scientific discoveries and demonstrations. Throughout the week, the children focused on 'observing over time' and enjoyed working scientifically together in their classes. They also travelled back in time to learn about a key scientist in history.
