We celebrated British Science Week from 10th-17th March. The theme of the week was 'connections'. At Killigrew, we focused on the connection between animals, humans and their habitats. We hope that you like our science week photographs.



We launched the week with an exciting visit from Ark Farm. Each class got to visit the farm where they were able to learn about and interact with the animals.





Throughout the week, the children took part in some thought-provoking virtual workshops from Science Farm where they learnt about the connection between pigs and jumbo jets, tractors and space and sheep and seaweed.

The children were also encouraged to use their 'working scientifically' skills in their science lessons where they took part in investigations linked to these.
