- Click on the instrument that you are interested in
- Choose **the lesson length** you wish to have (please note shared (pair)/group lessons are subject to enough children signing up to create a viable group. If they are unable to offer this, they will contact you and offer you an alternative shared or individual lesson)
- Once you have selected the course type click on 'Add to Basket'
- Fill in the full details to complete registration.*

If you already have an account with Hertfordshire Music Service, you will then get the opportunity to login with your existing information. Once you have registered, you will automatically be added to HMS waiting list and contacted once lessons become available.
