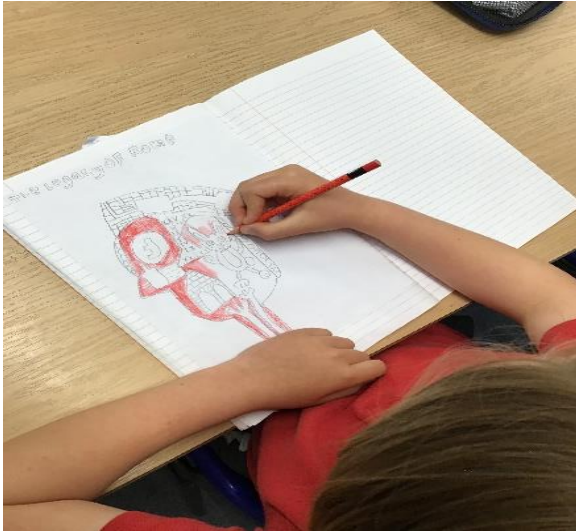

Our Y6 girls competed against all three Primary Schools seeded in our group, but unfortunately, we were unable to finish top of our group.

After such a successful season, it was great to see our girls show great maturity by being humble in victory throughout the year but also graceful in defeat at this competition.



Girls District Cup Success



Killigrew girls competed in the final knockout rounds of the St Albans district on Thursday at Colney Heath FC.

We were seeded against a strong Bowmansgreen in the semi-final. It was a well battled game, but we were victorious winning 3-2 with goals coming from Georgina (2) and Grace (1).

In the final, we were seeded against Aboyne Lodge. It was an entertaining game with both teams demonstrating excellent football with

Aboyne scoring a goal just in the first half. Throughout the season, Killigrew has shown resilience, perseverance and determination and once again showed these qualities in the second half.

Less than 5 minutes before the end of the game, Aboyne were still winning 1-0 before Killigrew scored two great goals from Georgina and Grace within a crazy 90 second spell. The game finished and Killigrew became the District Cup champions for the first time.
