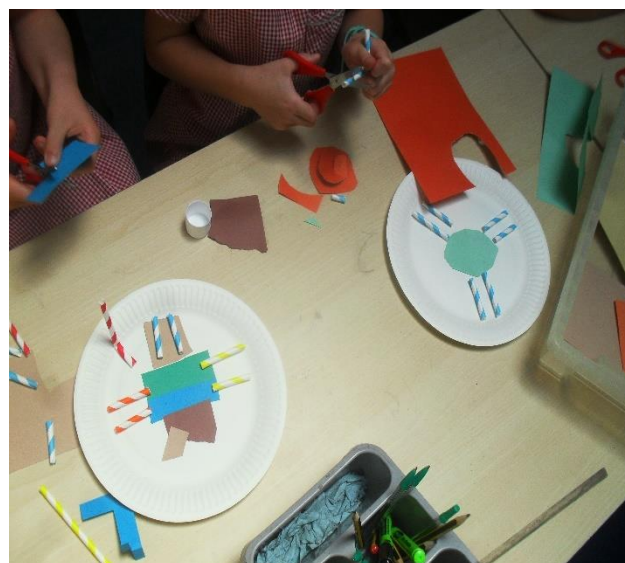
Valuables

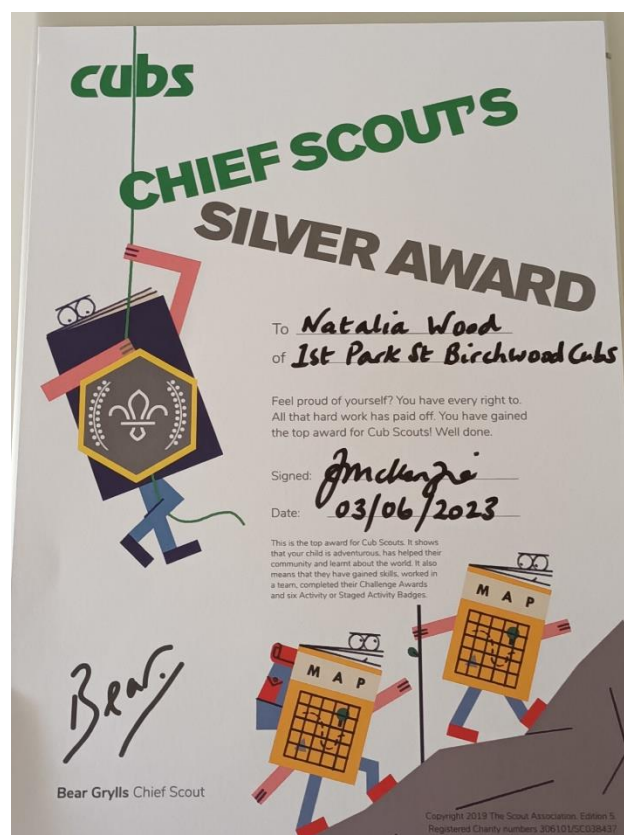
The ATA's are working on renewing the travel award, so we need to hear from as many children as possible. Many thanks.
