Childcare Choices

You could be saving money on childcare costs but might not know what support you might be eligible for. The Childcare Choices website brings together all the existing childcare offers in one place.

You might be eligible to use more than one childcare scheme together. From next year even more help is on the way:

- From April 2024, eligible working parents in England with children aged 2 will have access to 15 hours childcare.
- From September 2024, the 15 hours childcare offer will be expanded to eligible working parents in England with children between 9 and 23 months old.
- From September 2025, eligible working parents in England with children between 9 months up to school age will have access to 30 hours childcare.

Support is also expanding for primary-school aged children. From September 2024, parents/carers are expected to see an expansion in the availability of childcare before and after school, between 8am and 6pm, also known as 'wraparound care'.

Neurodiverse children

A Neurodiversity Support Hub has been launched which is open Monday-Friday from 9am-1pm. Please note, no diagnosis is required to access the support and the helpline is open to parents and carers.
