Dear Parents,

Y6 Residential Trip to Manor Adventure 2nd-6th October (Culmington Manor, Seifton, Craven Arms, Shropshire SY7 9BY)

As there are just a few days before the Y6 residential trip, here are some important reminders.

<u>Today</u>

- Please ensure that you have indicated whether or not you give consent for us to administer Calpol and/or Nurofen using School Gateway.
- Please ensure that you have filled in the consent form for us to administer any other medicine to your child while on school journey.

<u>Monday</u>

- Please administer any travel sickness tablets before school. Ensure you have completed a consent form for medication for the return journey.
- Put your child's nut free packed lunch (in a disposable bag) and their drink (in a named, refillable plastic bottle) in their hand luggage.
- Please remember not to pack any snacks/sweets in your child's bags.
- Your child must wear their red Killigrew cap when they leave-please do not pack it.
- Any medication (in its original packaging in a clear plastic bag, clearly labelled with your child's name) and completed consent forms must be handed to Mrs Kerner at 8:30am in the junior library. Children are not allowed to carry their own creams or inhalers. Their group leader will always have the child's inhaler/EpiPen with them.
- At 8.30am put your child's holdall, (including sleeping bag, pillow and pillowcase) and hand luggage in the junior hall then say an individual goodbye on the playground at 8:40am.
- The coach will leave at approximately 9.30am. The children will be led out to the coach by their group leaders and you will have the chance to wave as they board the coach.

Packing

There is a wet room at Manor Adventure, but it takes a while for things to dry. Please ensure that your child has enough clothing as they will get wet and muddy. Over the past two years, children have run out of dry trainers, so please ensure that they have at least two pairs of

comfortable trainers plus one pair of shoes that may get very wet and muddy.

- Do not pack Wellington boots as the children are not allowed to wear them on several activities.
- It can get cold at night, so warm pyjamas are a must!
- For some activities the children need long sleeve tops and trousers-they are not allowed to wear shorts.
- Please ensure that you supply plenty of hair ties if your child has long hair. Hair must be tied up for all activities.
- Please encourage your child to do their own packing, under your supervision, so that they are aware of what is in their bag. This will help them at the end of the week when they have to do their own packing. Please label all clothes and possessions including socks and underwear.

Useful information

- No jewellery, makeup, perfume or hair straighteners
- Roll on deodorant only (no sprays)
- Denim jeans are not ideal for outdoor use
- The children should not take anything of value whether in monetary or sentimental terms.
- They should not bring any money
- Please don't pack any valuable items e.g. expensive clothing and footwear, mobile phones or handheld games consoles. Digital cameras and any devices with a recording facility are not allowed.

<u>Friday</u>

The coach is scheduled to return to school at approximately 2:30pm, subject to Friday afternoon traffic. If the coach is significantly delayed, we will let you know. In the past, children have been extremely disappointed if no one is here to welcome them back. We recommend that you arrive at school in advance of the scheduled return time.

We will send you a message once the children arrive at Manor Adventure. I am in contact with the school journey party at least once a day so please keep an eye on your e-mail for messages and updates throughout the week. We will endeavour to update Twitter too, so please make sure that you are following us.
